All the coaches and locomotives have been shunted down to the Diesel Depot for safe keeping, leaving the steam sheds eerily silent. Negotiations and meetings with Spoornet are still ongoing and we just hope that the Railway authorities will sign the necessary documents very soon to enable the train to, literally, get back on track.
