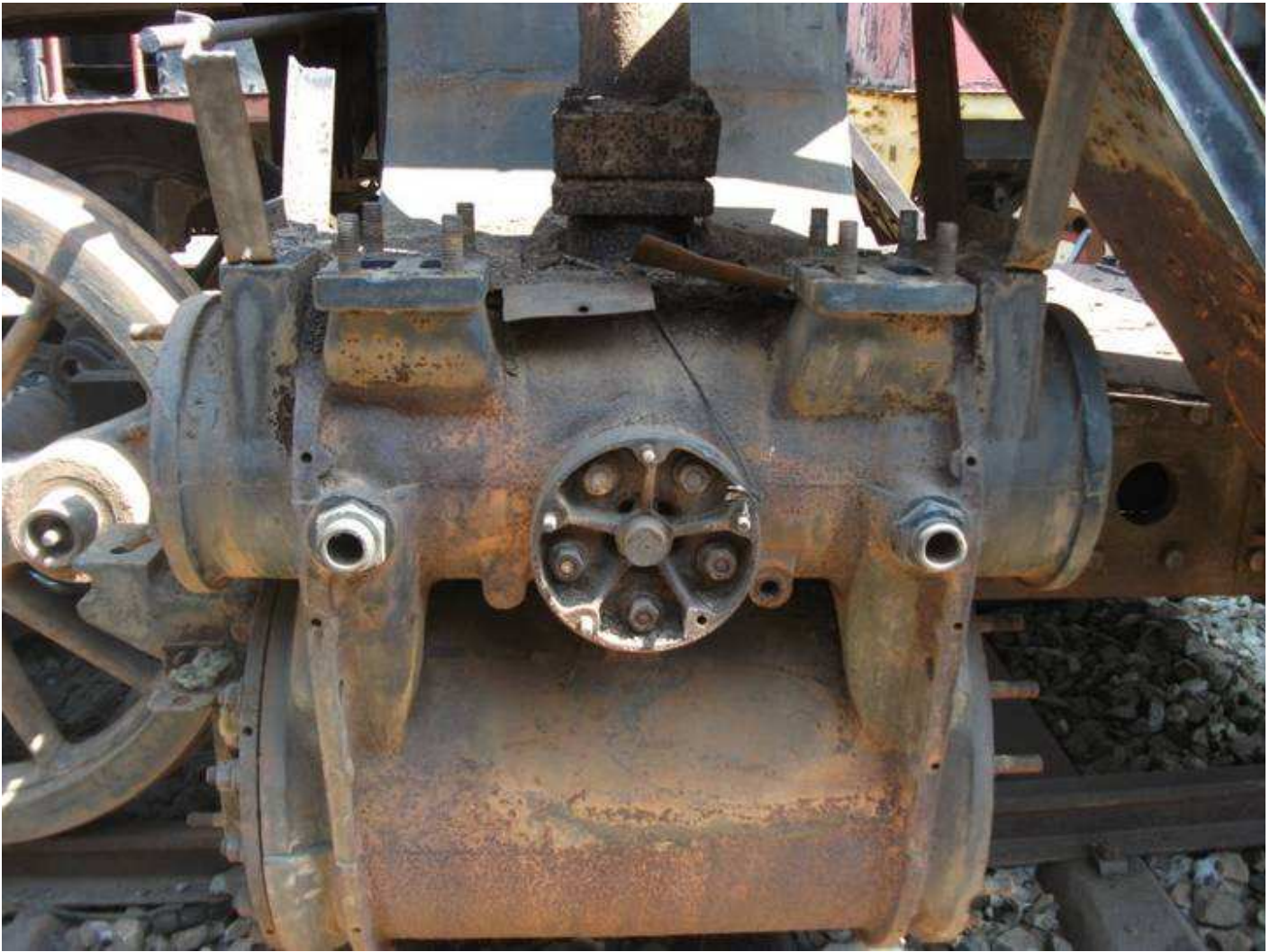




I Stood for a while next to the special S Classes, this was the very first time I ever had the privilege to stand next to a S class ever and all I could say is" What have they done to you! "

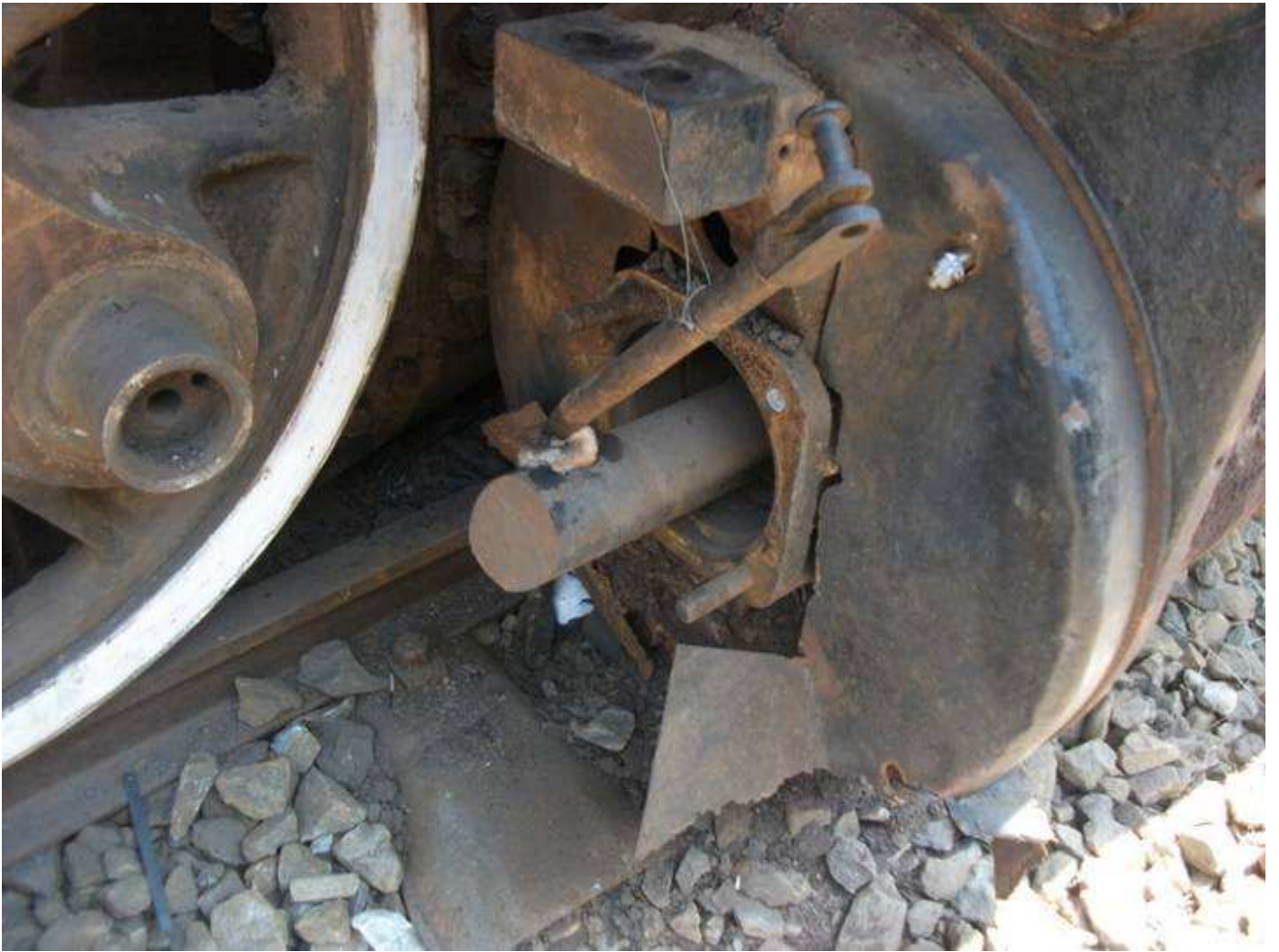

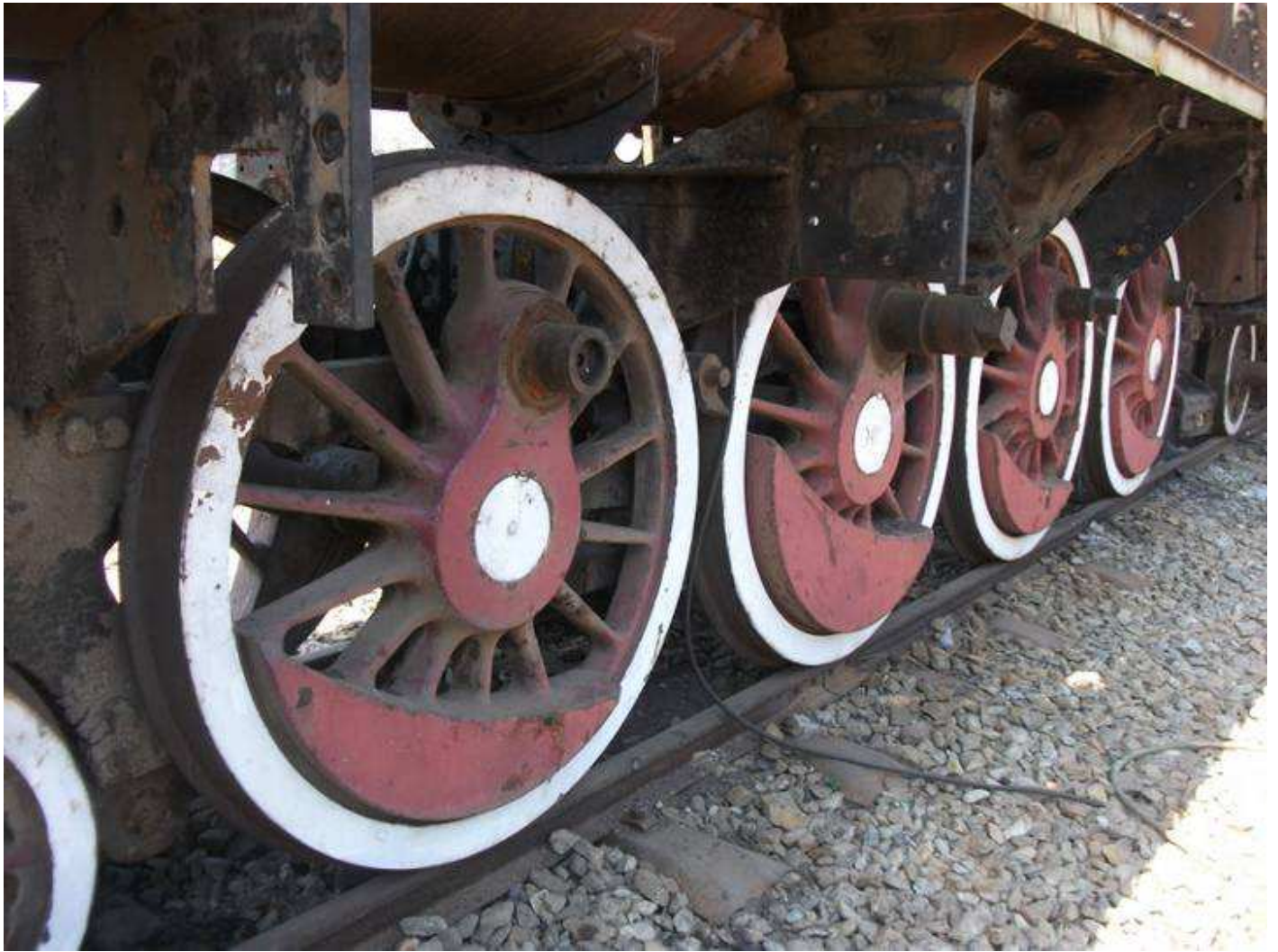


























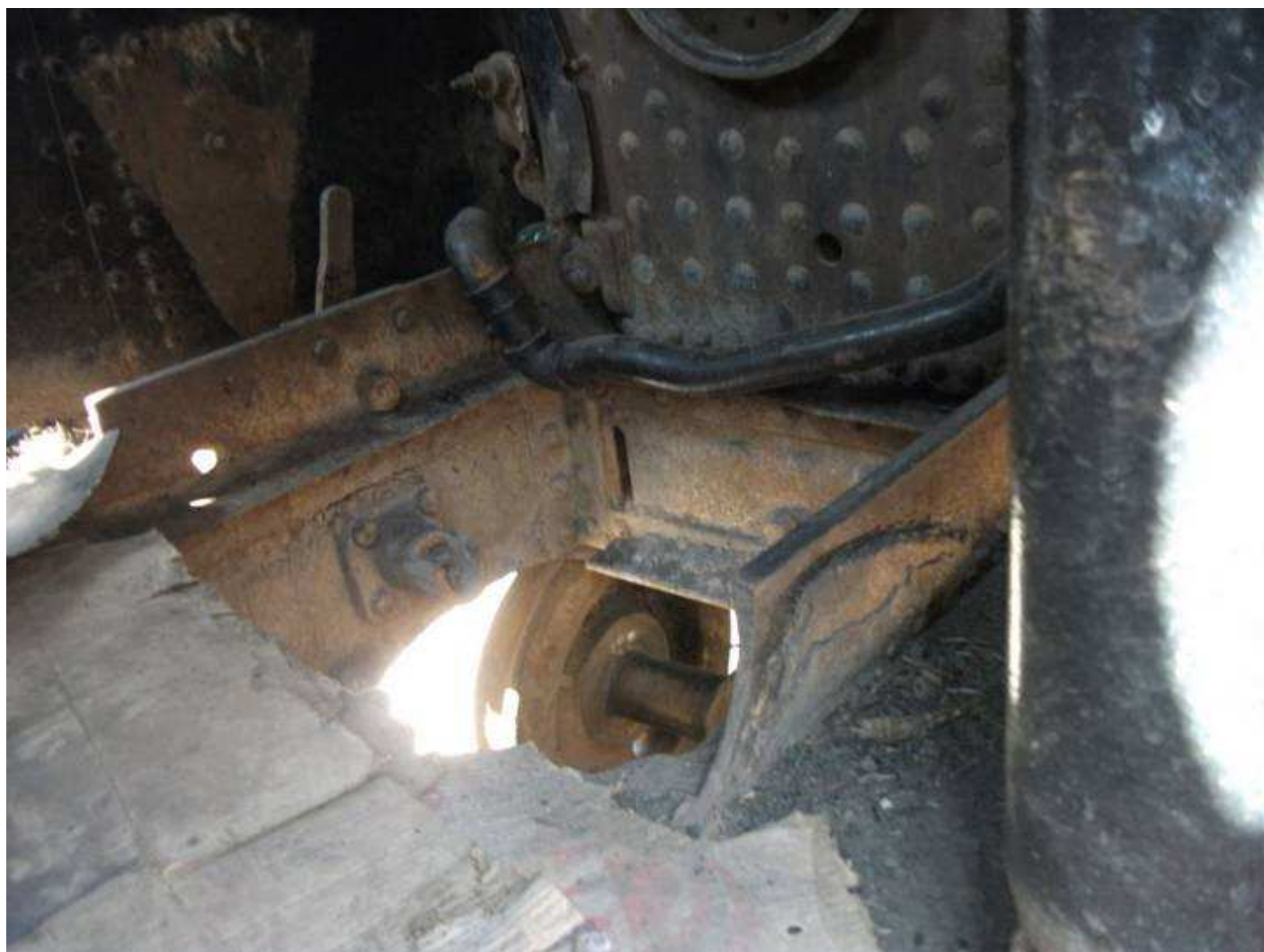






Below: A Loco Kaya!
