Sandstone is an oasis of steam and vintage preservation across all disciplines. With plenty of rare machinery to view in action and sheds packed full of interesting survivors, a visit to Sandstone is a must!

To make things hassle-free for international visitors, Sandstone has commissioned UK-based tour company Geoff's Trains to offer a facility to international visitors.

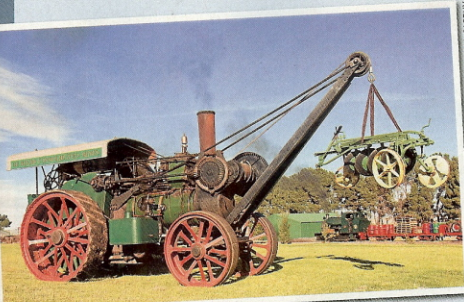
Proprietor Geoff Cooke has produced a package covering the period of 8-17 April that will include travel from Johannesburg to Sandstone and accommodation while there. A coach will then be used for transfers and for day trips for the ladies and a visit to the Bloemfontein works to meet Lukas Nel and

find out about the restoration of NGG11 and other narrow gauge locomotives. Geoff has also added a special photographic event in Pretoria with Friends of the Rail before you head home.

Geoff Cooke will host the tour. He has run a number of special events at Sandstone, and his knowledge of Sandstone and his relationship with the Gala team will ensure that you get the very best out of this exciting event.

The week-long extravaganza will feature the following:

- A total of 22 narrow gauge locomotives will operate throughout the week – hauling period consists drawn from the 200-strong narrow gauge carriage and wagon collection at Sandstone Estates. McLaren compound traction engine debut.
- Double-double header. For the first time ever we will place all four Sandstone Garratts to work hauling one train. The numbers are NGG13 No 49, NGG16 No 153, NGG16 No 88, and NGG16 No 113.
- Sandstone's collection of traction engines, historic agricultural machinery, military vehicles, classic cars, buses and commercial vehicles (with many rare breeds) will all be accessible to visitors and will be mobilised on a daily basis to enhance the trackside photographic possibilities.
- Special programmes for dedicated photographers will be run with early morning and evening run-pasts being co-ordinated on a daily basis. Some of the world's top railway photographers will be working to co-ordinate the best combinations of locomotives, wagons, freight loads etc. in the best locations to take advantage of the outstanding light and scenery options.
- For those interested, Geoff's Tours will dedicate a day during the week for an organised tour of the Bloemfontein rebuild facility in the old SAREH steam sheds at Bloemfontein (approx 90 mins drive from Sandstone) followed by an in-depth evaluation of the restoration of NGG11 No. 52, as well as a number of smaller O&K's – together with other locomotives currently being rebuilt.
