Our signature loco for 2013 is all but complete... a world class historical 2-ft Narrow Gauge locomotive of great significance.



#### 2) New Samil 100 Gun tractor arrives.

A brand new Gun tractor which represented the State-of-the-art of the South African Defence Force over the past 30-years or so is now on the farm. This unit has been fully refurbished to as new condition by a company that specialises in these type of rebuilds, namely OTT. OTT work closely with the Sandstone Heritage Trust and do their best to assist us to acquire items of significant interest in the Military vehicle field.



## 3) Hunslet Diesel receives engine transplant.

A Hunslet Diesel which is incredibly valuable as a shunting engine, particularly prior to large events such as Stars of Sandstone, is receiving a new 6LW Gardner engine kindly donated by a Broomwade compressor that we have.

The Hunslet's existing engine will be overhauled and will be installed in the Broomwade compressor.
